1. Submissions will be evaluated by the Evaluation Committee based on the criteria specified in the Framework and Detailed Regulations (in accordance with the Submission Evaluation Sheet – Appendix 1):
 - 1) compliance with National Smart Specializations (NSS, polish KIS) – a mandatory non-scoring criterion,
 - 2) the validity of the proposed activities in the context of the intended method of commercialisation and in relation to the level of technological/economic readiness – weight: **35%**,
 - 3) the validity of the proposed costs of pre-implementation work – weight: **35%**,
and
 - 4) implementation of challenges/needs defined by socio-economic partners – weight: **20%**,
 - 5) connection with eco-innovation/implementation of the 6R principles – weight: **10%**,
2. Funding may be awarded to Submissions that have received a score of at least **65%** of the possible points.
3. Submissions will be subject to financial evaluation, during which the budget may be negotiated.
